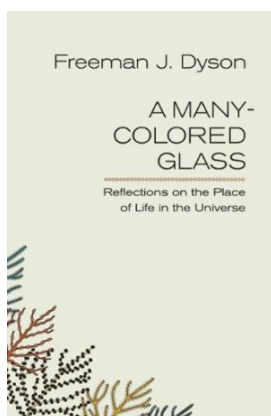


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A MANY-COLORED GLASS: REFLECTIONS ON THE PLACE OF LIFE IN THE UNIVERSE
