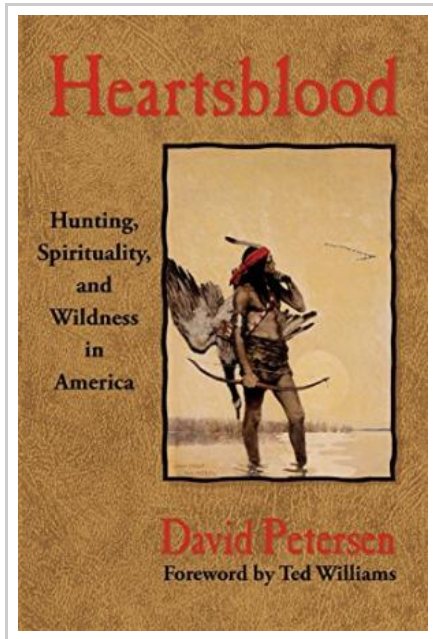




Heartsblood: Hunting, Spirituality, and Wildness in America
