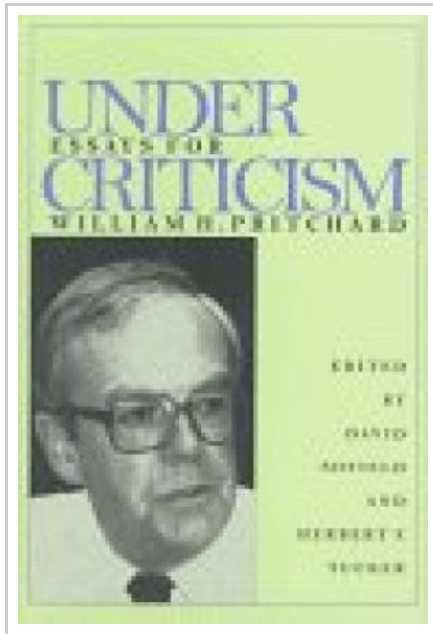




Under Criticism: Essays for William H.Pritchard

Marxist, humanist, phenomenologist, de-constructionist, feminist, classicist, post-modernist, and revanchist positions all are aired.



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
