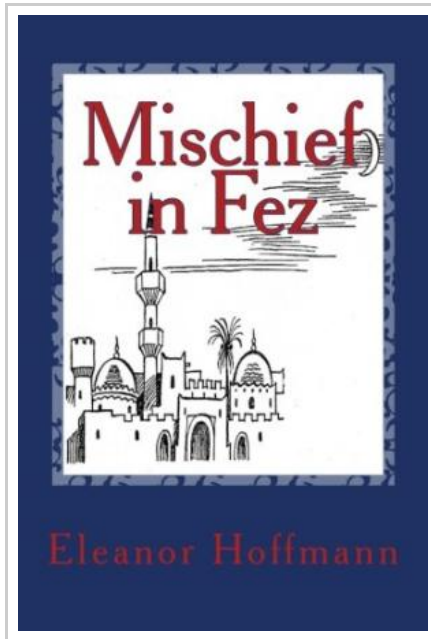




Mischief in Fez (Paperback)
